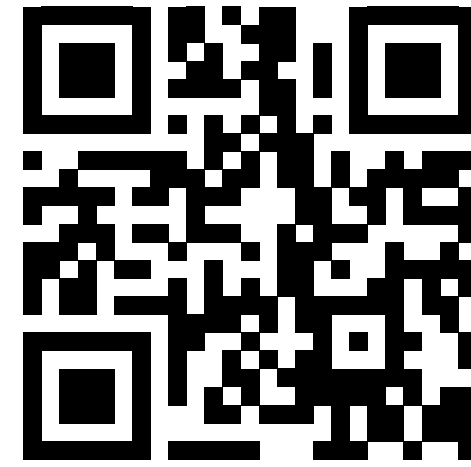


- The Hawk Band travels all around the state of Texas. This sometimes requires the use of Charter Transportation

MEET OUR ENSEMBLES

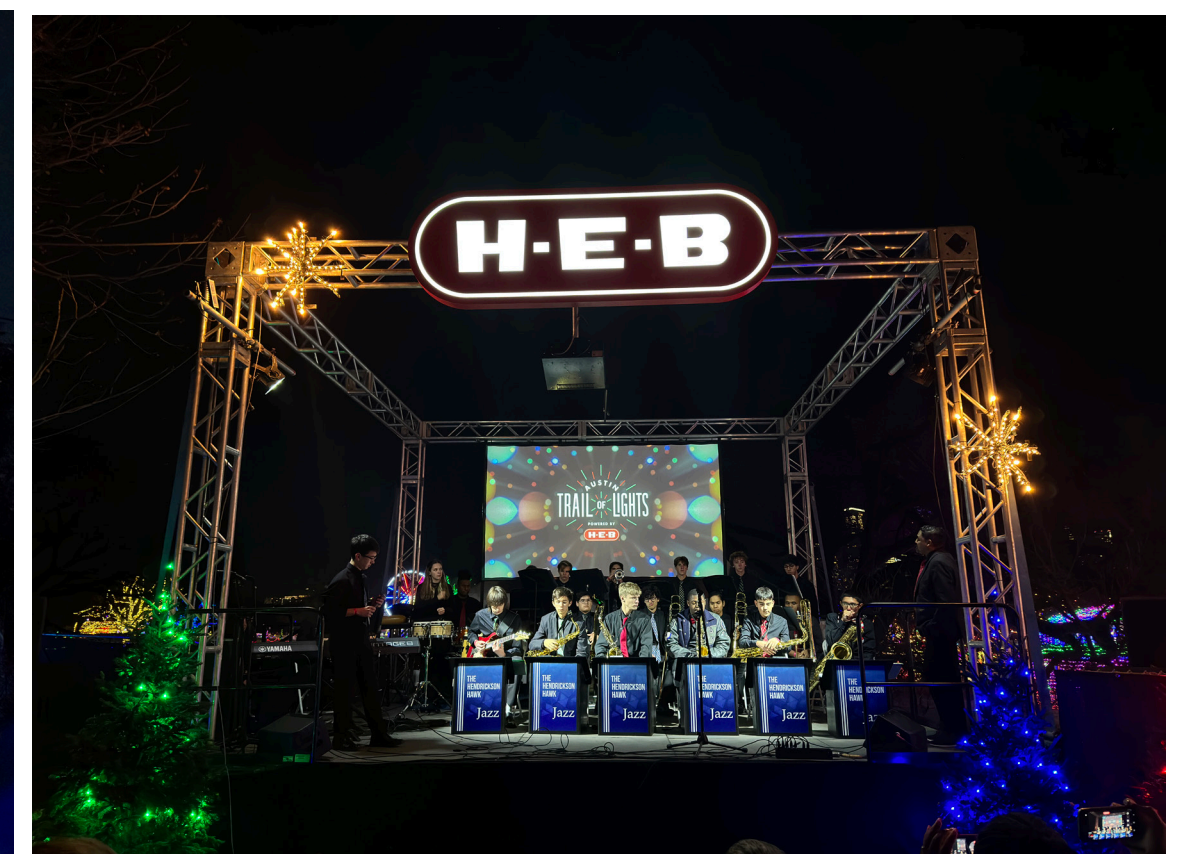
PERCUSSION ENSEMBLE

JAZZ BAND

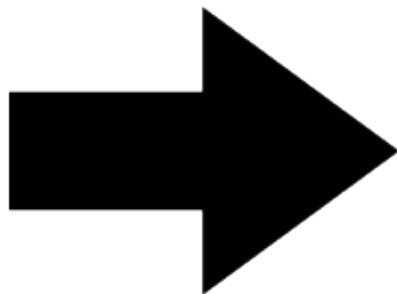
